Mon., Sept. 25 – Last Ladies League Game

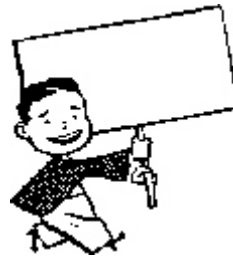
Sat., Aug. 12 – Golf Assoc. Dog Fight Trip

Coming up in August is our Oak Hills Benefit Tournament. 60% of the \$30 entry fee will be paid in prize money. Five place prizes will be awarded. Your average score must be included with sign-up, as teams will be formed accordingly. Be honest! Players with average score between 65-75 will be deemed (A) players, avg. score 76-82 will be (B) players, avg. score 83-88 (C) players, and 89 or higher will be (D) players. B,C, & D players will be listed on a score card, then each (A) player will draw a card randomly for his or her team. Up to 10 feet of string can be purchased for .50 / foot. Teams must use the drive of each player three times during the round. We look forward to having a great, competitive tournament.



RULES THAT MUST BE FOLLOWED. . . Red or



green flags are posted on the first and tenth tees, signifying cart path rules. Red requires that carts remain on the cart path only; green indicates that carts may go 90 degrees onto the fairways, but not in the roughs. **Please do**

not drive in the roughs. Observe the No Carts signs. Attention to these rules will protect your course and improve play for you and all our membership. Additionally, there can only be three carts to any group of no more than five golfers. **Remember,** also, to **repair all ball marks** on the green. And if you see another ball mark other than yours, fix it as well.
