When playing during the winter always check on tees 1 and 10 for daily cart path rules. A red flag means cart path only while a green flag means 90 degrees to your ball in the fairways only.



Golf Rule/Question of the Month

Q. My Ball Struck Overhead Power Lines - Do I Get to Replay the Shot?

A. This situation falls broadly under Rule 33-8a; it's specifically addressed in Decision 33-8/13, which states the following:

"The Committee may establish Local Rules for local abnormal conditions if they are consistent with the policy set forth in Appendix I." (Appendix I is the appendix that covers Local Rules.)

So, broadly speaking, your local course or club can enact rules specific to conditions at your course, as long as they do so in accordance with the guidelines set forth in Appendix I (covering Local Rules) to the Rules of Golf. **Oak Hills has a local rule where shots which strike a power line must be replayed.**
