Observe the No Carts signs.** Attention to these rules will protect your course and improve play for you and all our membership. Additionally, there can only be three carts to any group of no more than five golfers.

Remember, also, to **repair all ball marks** on the green. And if you see another ball mark other than yours, fix it as well.
